Working Conditions	<p>Telephone and computer work at home or in the Richmond High School setting</p> <p>Meeting Youth and adults in the High School, coffee shops, churches and other public places</p> <p>Use of own vehicle to travel to the locations required</p> <p>Meeting and working with other YU Richmond staff, Greater Vancouver staff, volunteers and Richmond Area Director</p> <p>Meeting, developing and maintaining ministry partnerships with church, school and community organizations</p> <p>Occasional evening and weekend work. Occasional day and extended trips.</p> <p>Salary, expenses and benefits, (as applicable), are all raised by the applicant, with extensive training and support from the YU Richmond team</p>
Time Commitment	<p>Part Time, at 16 hours per week to start</p> <p>May develop into a full time position</p>
Training	<p>Orientation, general training upon acceptance</p> <p>Ministry and partner development training upon acceptance</p> <p>Hands on ministry training in partnership with other Richmond staff, 2 year credentialing training</p> <p>Continuous commitment to ministry development, training under the Greater Vancouver umbrella</p>
Supervision and Feedback	<p>Weekly meetings with supervisor and other YU team</p> <p>Direct reporting to supervisor</p>
